- (c) to promote a sense of brotherhood and fraternal spirit among the membership and to encourage cooperation to achieve the purposes of the organization and to go beyond such purposes to create mutual respect and camaraderie among the membership and their families

Pelham Civic Association Programs and Activities

Needy Cases/Good Neighbor Programs

Our membership assists the less fortunate families in our community with food, financial support, toys and gifts throughout the year. We also provide food, financial support and volunteer time at local soup kitchens. In addition, we sponsor an annual golf outing benefit with all proceeds going to this program.

Scholarship/Community Awards Program

Each School year, three substantial Pelham civic Association scholarship awards among others are issued to high school students residing in Pelham who exhibit civic leadership, community activity and charitable support.

Community Forums

From time to time, we sponsor special forums to help our membership and their families better understand vital issues of concern to the Town and community. Examples have included presentations on the Town Library, school board matters including presentations, teen drug abuse and school expansion proposals.

Summer Olympics

Every June, we run an outdoor Olympic sports event for all the children of Pelham between the grades of K through five at Glover Field. All participants receive T-Shirts, medals, food and refreshments.

Fund Raiser

To help finance all our programs, and activities listed above, we organize an Annual Dinner Dance and Raffle, which generally held in October of each year.

Donations

We provide financial assistance to and participate in other worthwhile causes and organizations including youth sports, programs for disabled, senior citizens activities, special programs and the like.

Membership meetings

Our monthly general membership meetings are normally held on the first Wednesday after the first Thursday of each month at the Richard J. Daronoco Townhouse located at 20 Fifth Avenue. Spouses are invited to the December (Christmas) and February (Valentine's Day) Social/meetings usually held at a local restaurant or catering facility.

Social Events

Individually defrayed by the members, various social events are held throughout the year, often on an as hoc basis, and have typically included Yankee games, fishing trips and various other entertainment venues.
